Mobile phones **are made** of glass, plastic and different kinds of metal in a complex production process. First, the phone **is designed** and a prototype **is made**. Improvements **are made** to the design before the hardware **is produced**. Then, the software **is installed**. The battery **is added**, and the phone **is tested**. The instruction manual **is written**, and finally the phone **is packaged** and **sent** to the shops.

The first mobile phone call **was made** by Martin Cooper of Motorola.

1973

The first text message **was sent** (it said *Merry Christmas!*).

1992

Invention of the touch screen

2001

Installation of the first 4G network

1979

The first commercial phone network **was installed** in Tokyo, Japan (but the first 3G network **wasn't installed** until 1992).

1998

The first mobile with a colour screen **was produced** (but mobiles with cameras weren't sold until 2000).
