# YES/NO QUESTIONS

To make a question with a YES or NO answer we put **CAN** at the beginning of the sentence before the subject (pronoun or noun). Then comes the main verb.

Can I?	Yes, you can.	No, you can't.
Can you?	Yes, I can.	No, I can't.
Can he?	Yes, he can.	No, he can't.
Can she?	Yes, she can.	No, she can't.
Can it?	Yes, it can.	No, it can't.
Can we?	Yes, you can.	No, you can't.
Can you?	Yes, we can.	No, we can't.
Can they?	Yes, they can.	No, they can't.
